

The Justice Is Global Candidate Pledge

To save the planet from climate catastrophe and to stop the escalation of nationalist violence, we need to work across borders for equitable growth, international cooperation, and sustainability.

As a candidate and/or current office holder, I pledge to:

- Support structural reforms to the global economy that will create good jobs for all and expand public goods, increase the power of workers everywhere, reduce the power of corporations and oligarchs, and combat the root causes of authoritarianism and nationalism.
- Help end the pandemic everywhere by supporting an international waiver for patents for COVID vaccines and other medications, calling on US pharmaceutical companies to share their technologies globally, and supporting greater funding for vaccine production and healthcare domestically and globally.
- Support a Global Green New Deal to fight and stop climate change worldwide by ensuring the US provides its fair share of international financing for clean energy infrastructure, climate adaptation, and climate reparations, providing debt restructuring or cancellation for developing countries, and reforming international trade and investment rules.
- Support policies and diplomacy that strengthen international cooperation in order to address all of our shared global challenges and achieve a sustainable, equitable global economy for people of all countries
- Reject a worldview of zero-sum competition between the US and China and avoid rhetoric that scapegoats China or people of Chinese descent for social and political problems in the United States
- Support reductions in the US military budget in order to increase funding to meet human needs in the United States and abroad
- Reject campaign contributions over \$200 from executives, lobbyists, and PACs affiliated with the military industrial complex, the fossil fuel industry, or pharmaceutical corporations
